

# **EU Corporate Sustainability Due** Diligence Directive ("CS3D")



23 February 2022 –
EU Commission
published a proposal
for a directive on
corporate
sustainability due
diligence obligations.



1 December 2022 the Council adopted its General Approach on the Commission's proposal.



1 June 2023 - the Parliament adopted its position.



Trialogue negotiations underway, with the legislation expected to be adopted in 2024.
